MEMBERSHIP NOTES

NOTE 1 For example: Son of Charles Maclean, Solicitor, London, born Edinburgh, 1870, died Bournemouth, 1950; son Donald Maclean, Merchant, Edinburgh, born Tobermory, 1850, died Haddington, 1920; son of Charles Maclaine, Fisherman, Tobermory, born 1825, etc. as far back as known.

Please give places and dates of birth and death of ancestors and burial if known. It is not essential that this question be answered in full. The purpose is to provide genealogical historical information for the future.

- NOTE 2**
- (1) Membership of the Association is open to-
 - (a) Persons bearing either by birth or by marriage, the surname MACLEAN, in any of its various forms and spellings, or that of any of the recognised septs:

(BEATH, BEATON, BEETON, BETHUNE, BLACK, CLANACHAN, GARVIE, GILLAN, GILLEAN, GILLON, GILZEAN, LEAN, MacBEATH, MacBETH, MacCORMICK, McCracken, MacFADDEN, MacFADYEN, MacFADZEAN, MacFERGAN, MacGILVRA, MacGILVRAY, MacILDUY, MacILVERA, McILVORAY, MacLERGAIN, MacPHADDEN, MacRAING, MacRANKIN, MacVEAGH, MacVEY, PATON, PATTEN, PEDEN, RANKEN, RANKIN, RANKINE OR RANKING).

or any alternative spelling of these names.
 - (b) Persons bearing a surname other than MACLEAN, but whose spouse, parent, grandparent, or great grandparent bore either the name MACLEAN or one of the recognised names, as in (1) (a).
 - (2) The membership shall consist of Ordinary, Junior, Affiliate, Associate and Honorary members.
 - (a) Ordinary Members shall consist of those persons who qualify for membership under (1) (a) or (b).
 - (b) Junior Members shall consist of those up to the age of 18 years who qualify for membership under (1) (a) or (b).
 - (c) Affiliate Members shall consist of those who are husbands of clanswomen who are members of the Association and shall be eligible for Affiliate Membership and may hold office as a councillor.
 - (d) Associate Members shall consist of those who are not otherwise qualified for admission under the rules, who desire to show their adherence to the Clan MACLEAN and who by a vote of the Council shall be admitted to Associate membership of the Association, but may not hold office or vote.
 - (e) Honorary Members shall be nominated by a recommendation of the Council Members, followed by a vote in the affirmative by $\frac{3}{4}$ of those members present at an Annual General Meeting.
